- We desire to share the grace and truth of Christ with the world.

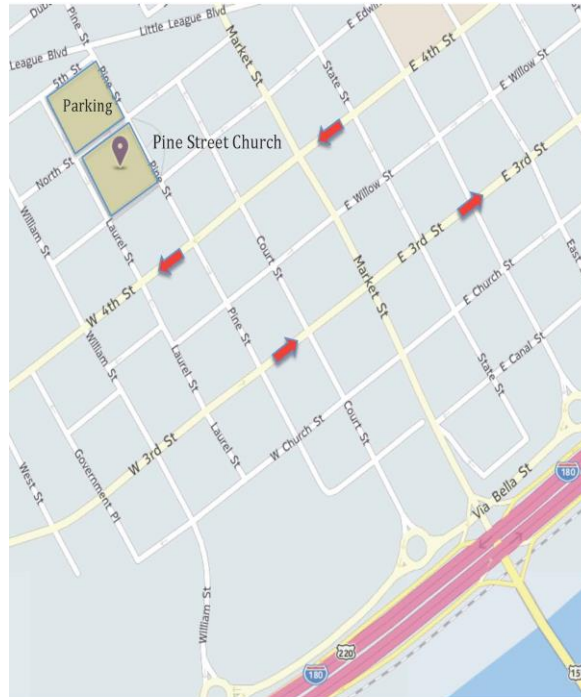
What we believe
